#### PRA RULEBOOK: CRR FIRMS: REPORTING PILLAR 2 AMENDMENT NO. 1 INSTRUMENT 2017

#### **Powers exercised**

- A. The Prudential Regulation Authority ("PRA") makes this instrument in the exercise of the following powers and related provisions in the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 ("the Act"):
  - (1) section 137G (The PRA's general rules);
  - (2) section 137T (General supplementary powers); and
- B. The rule-making powers referred to above are specified for the purpose of section 138G(2) (Rule-making instruments) of the Act.

## Pre-conditions to making

C. In accordance with section 138J of the Act (Consultation by the PRA), the PRA consulted the Financial Conduct Authority. After consulting, the PRA published a draft of proposed rules and had regard to representations made.

D. The PRA makes the rules in the Annex to this instrument.

#### Commencement

E. This instrument comes into force on 1 January 2018.

2	PILLAR 2 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS
<u>2.7</u>	A firm must complete the data item FSA076 for any wholesale portfolio of exposures for which capital requirements are calculated using the Standardised Approach to credit risk.
<u>2.8</u>	A firm must complete the data item FSA077 for any retail portfolio of exposures for which capital requirements are calculated using the Standardised Approach to credit risk.
